

Please obtain and send the following to UCP before the assessment:

- UCP's Background Information Packet (BIP)
- A copy of consumer's medical insurance card(s)
- A prescription for a "communication assessment" (this can be acquired from the consumer's primary care physician; it needs to specifically state "communication assessment")
- TriCare/TriWest Insurance Holders: It is required the consumer's PCM complete and fax a "TriCare Patient Referral/Authorization Form" to the TriWest Prior Authorization Department in lieu of a prescription for a "communication assessment". When the Assistive Technology Center receives approval of services the evaluation can be scheduled.

Please note: These items must be on file before the assessment is scheduled. Please mail or fax the necessary paperwork using the information provided below.
